The Sedgwick County Conservation District is a political subdivision of state government, established in 1945 and charged with the conservation of the natural resources of Sedgwick County. Our primary operating funds are provided exclusively through county tax funds, as appropriated through the Sedgwick County Commissioners; and Kansas State Water Plan funds, as outlined in K.S.A. 2-1907C. The public can also contribute to the Conservation District through memorial, honorarium and other gifts to help enhance our mission of conserving our natural resources for the future.

Conservation provides economic and environmental benefits directly to Sedgwick County and all residents; both urban and rural. Voluntary conservation practices enhance and protect water quality, and soil health, for community health and environmental benefits and now is your opportunity to support our conservation work.
