



Drinking Water Protection Incentive Program Site Specific Nutrient Management Plan

Nutrient management involves managing the amount, placement and timing of plant nutrients to obtain optimum yields and minimize the risk of surface and groundwater pollution. The Kansas Department of Health and Environment – Drinking Water Protection Incentive Program offers financial assistance as an incentive to assist operators in better achieving these goals.

- Must be approved Nutrient Management Plan that meets KDHE program requirements.
 - Grid or Zone Sampling + Data Analysis
 - Documentation is required of sampling and application; this will include the “As Applied Map” as well as invoices showing expenditures for nutrient management applications.
- All Nutrient Management Plans must be submitted to the Coordinator for approval and have a contract in place prior to implementation.
